General rules of academic reviewing (translated after Polish Scholarly Bibliography Web Portal, https://pbn.nauka.gov.pl/).

- 1. The article shall be reviewed independently by two different reviewers who are affiliated to the academic institution other than the author of the article.
- 2. In the case of an article written in a foreign [non-Polish] language, one of the reviewers must be affiliated to a foreign [non-Polish] academic institution located in the country other than the author's origin.
- 3. The review shall by anonymous. The so-called "double-blind review" method is recommended.
- 4. If the condition of anonymity cannot be met, the reviewer must not remain in any kind of interest conflict with the author, in particular:
- a) they shall not be related;
- b) they shall not remain in a professional relationship;
- c) they should not have been working in the same research team for two years prior the review process.
- 5. The review must be completed in a written form and contain a clear conclusion whether the article is publishable or not.
- 6. Criteria for publication as well as the review form shall be made public and accessible from the journal's website.
- 7. The reviewing process is anonymous. Once a year the journal shall publish a list of all reviewers.
